

Article on indictment charge against James M Webb

An indictment against James M. Webb, 17, of Gilbertsville, an inmate of the Binghamton State hospital, on a charge of second degree murder, will be sought, Mr. Grant announced. County Judge Lee D. VanWoert has signed an order directing his release from the state institution and he will be taken to Coopers-town the week of Nov. 13. Authorities at the Binghamton institution claim that they can find nothing wrong with the youth's mind making it prohibitive for him to remain at the instituton, Mr. Grant said.

The youth is accused of killing his mother with an axe the afternoon of June 30, 1933, as she was lying in bed.
