

## Craft Center open in 1970 at Morris

MORRIS — The Butternut Valley Arts and Crafts Center, Morris, was organized on Sept. 30, 1970, as a non-profit organization dedicated to the promotion and presentation of arts and crafts in this area.

It is administered by a Steering Committee of eight members consisting of Mrs. John Whitman (General Chairman), John Whitman, Roy Bartlett, John Dodge, May Millikan, Ina Rasmussen, Mary Lenhardt and Ray Clement. The Center is located near the center of town in Morris in the old library block, which has been made available through the courtesy of John Whitman. As of 15 Jan. 1971, there are 38 members.

The Center held its first Open House on Sunday, Jan. 24. A regular schedule of activities in both arts and crafts is planned for the late winter and spring.
