The varsity rifle team was started as a full time varsity letter sport in November of 1959. The team became affiliated with the National Rifle Association. The charter members of the varsity rifle team are Gregory Smith, Robert Bellot, Timothy Fay, James Matteson, Barry Valentine, Brent Cobb, Eric Shields, Chester Gunther, Daniel Morehouse, and Wayne Livingston.

This first year of competition the team engaged in matches on a home and home basis with the following teams: Otego, Schenevus, Norwich, McGraw, Deposit, Windsor, and Cincinnatus. At the time of this writing the team's record is 8 wins and 2 defeats. The team also participated in four NRA postal matches.

Varsity letters are given to those who participate in 60% of the matches. The three persons having the three highest individual averages for the season (as letter winners) will receive a special star letter award. The individual letterman having the highest average for the season will receive the Robert Platt Memorial Award. This award is in honor of Mr. Robert Platt, former coach, who lost his life in an auto accident.

If the team has a winning season it will participate in the Section 4 tournament at the IBM range in Johnson City on March 25, and in the NRA District Tournament at Deposit on April 14-15.
