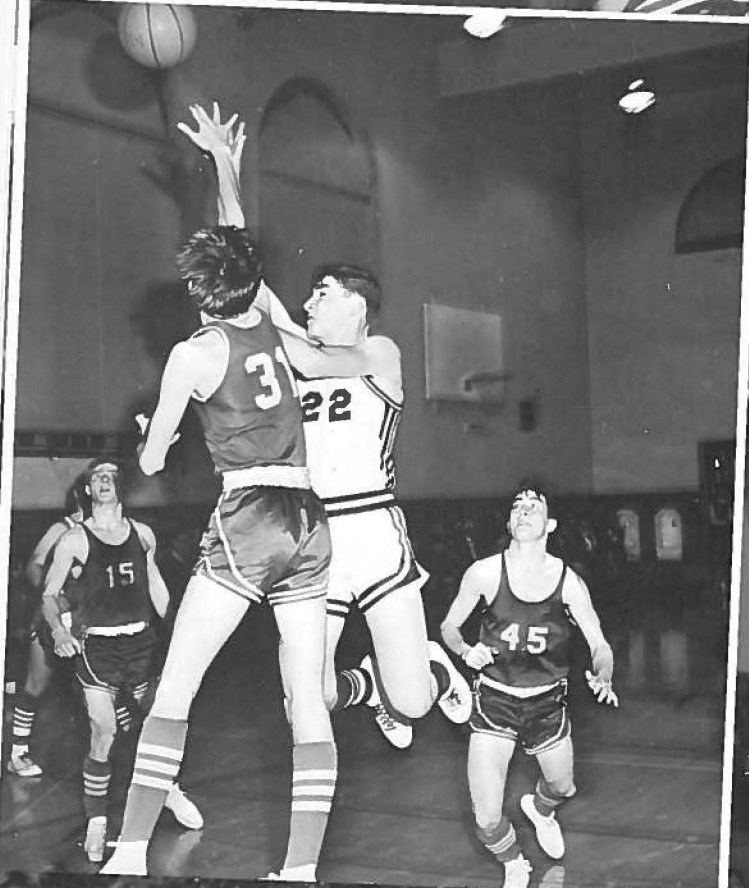
The 1966-67 Varsity has compiled a 12 and 4 record with the sectionals yet to go.

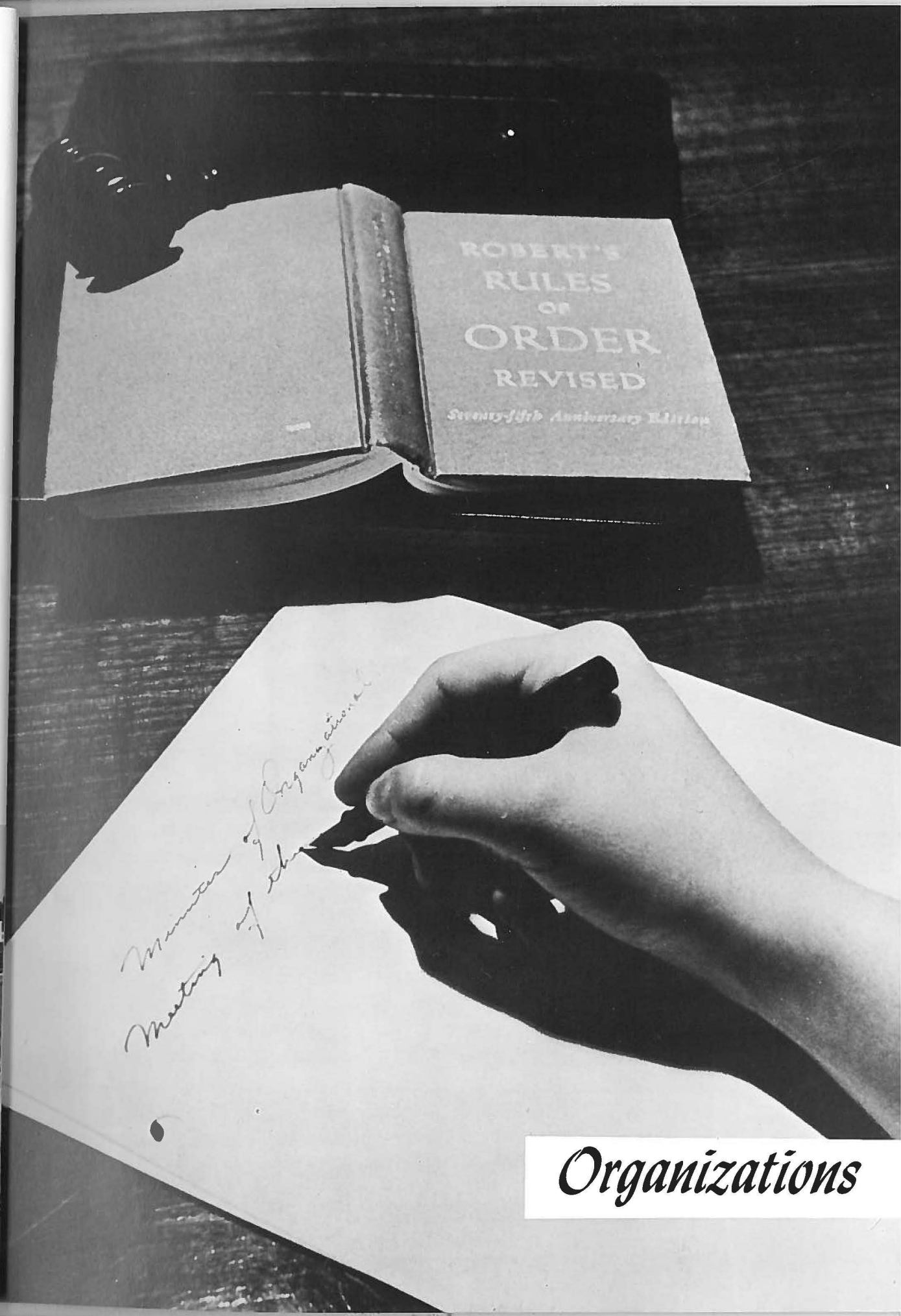

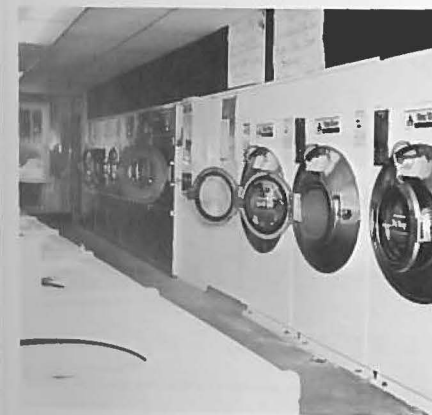
