As Seniors, looking back on what seems to us to be thirteen wonderful years of education, we recall first the unusual events.

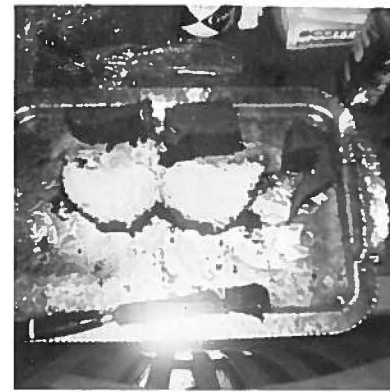
