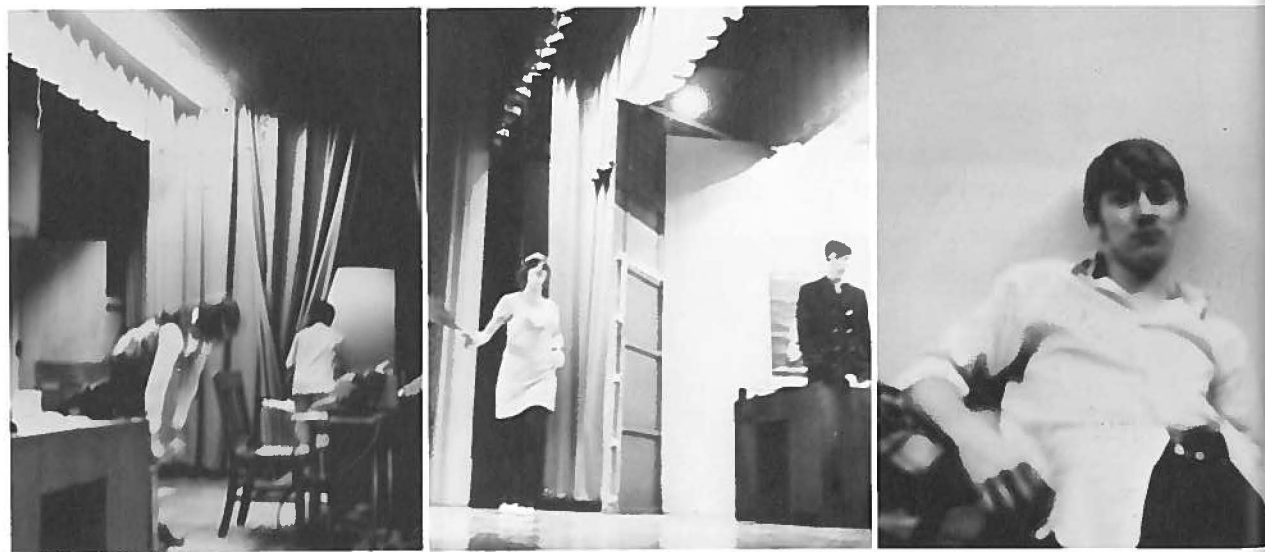
In seventh grade we were exposed to the hustle and bustle of changing classes, teachers, and rooms for eight periods a day.
