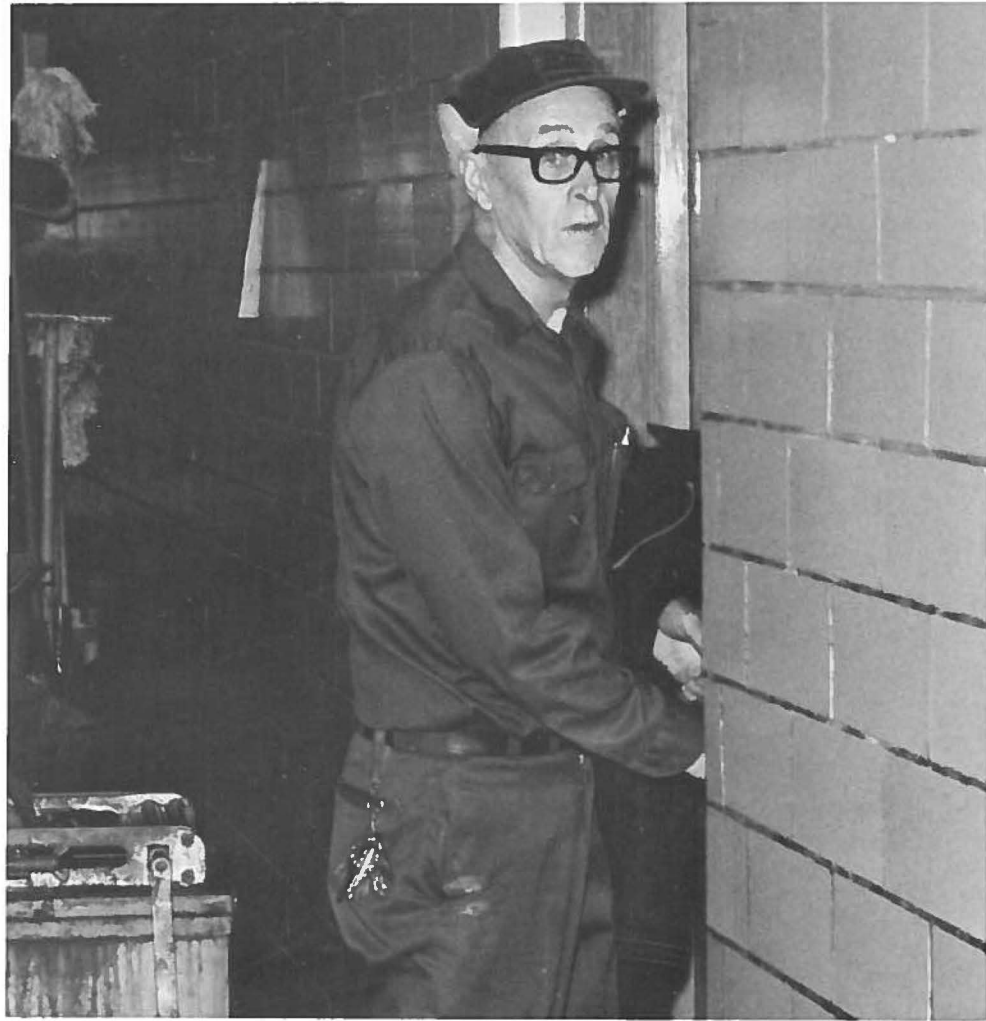

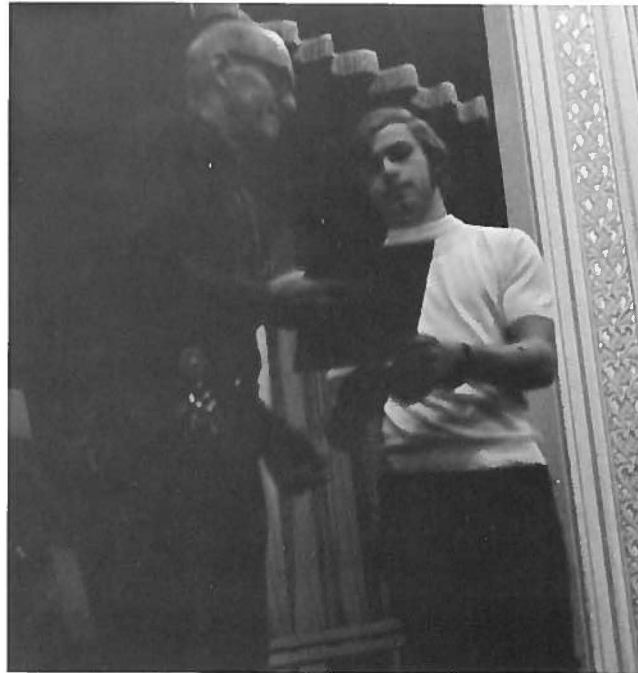

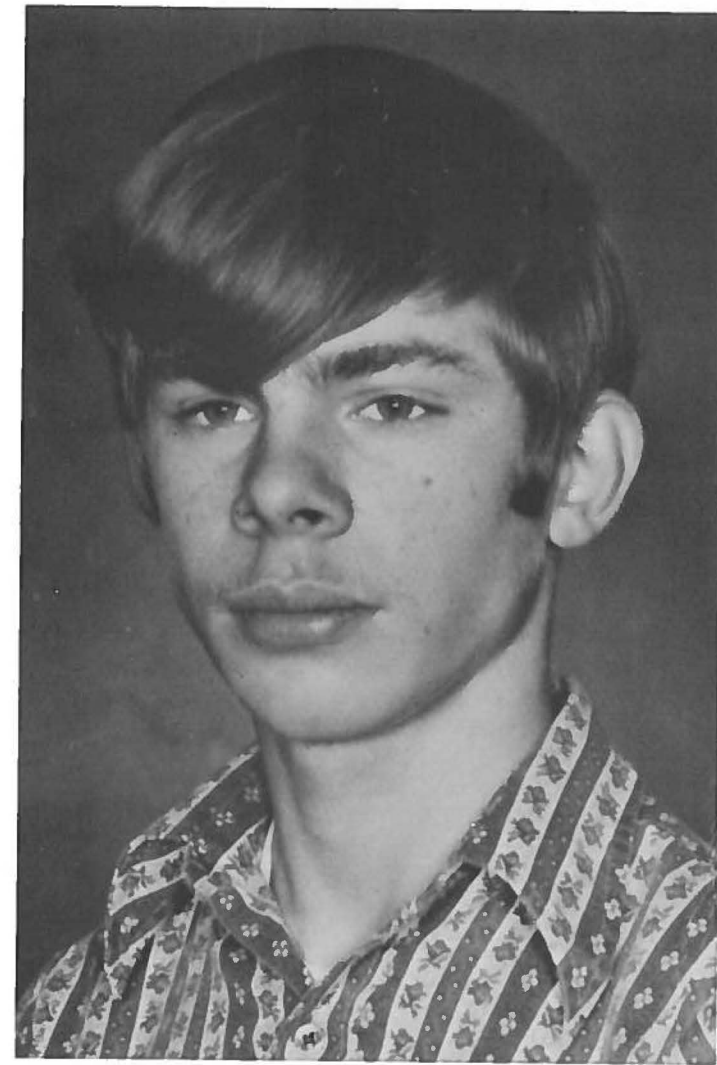


RAYMOND

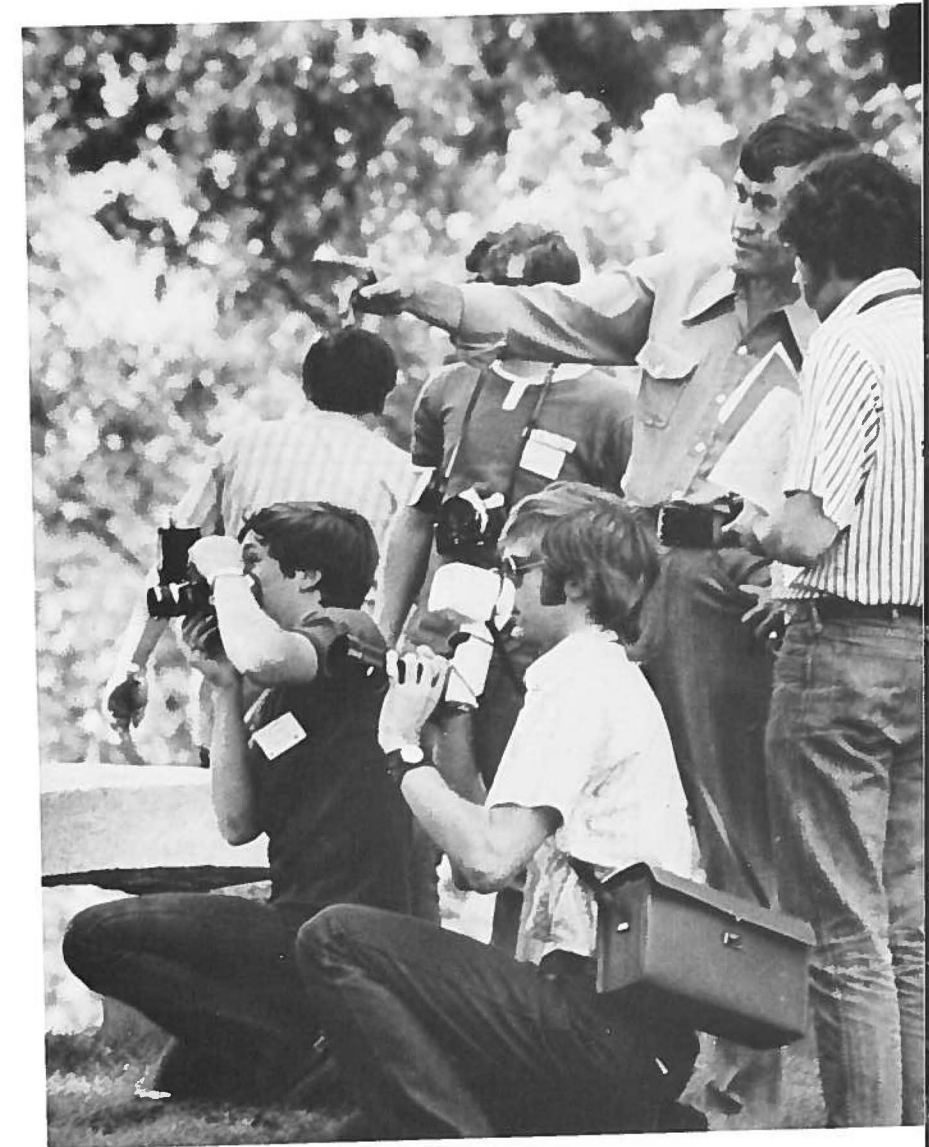


A FIRST BY VARDEN Student Yearbook Photographers Workshop "a Fantastic Success"

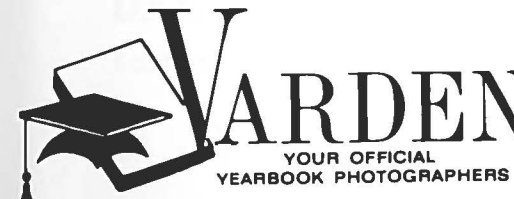

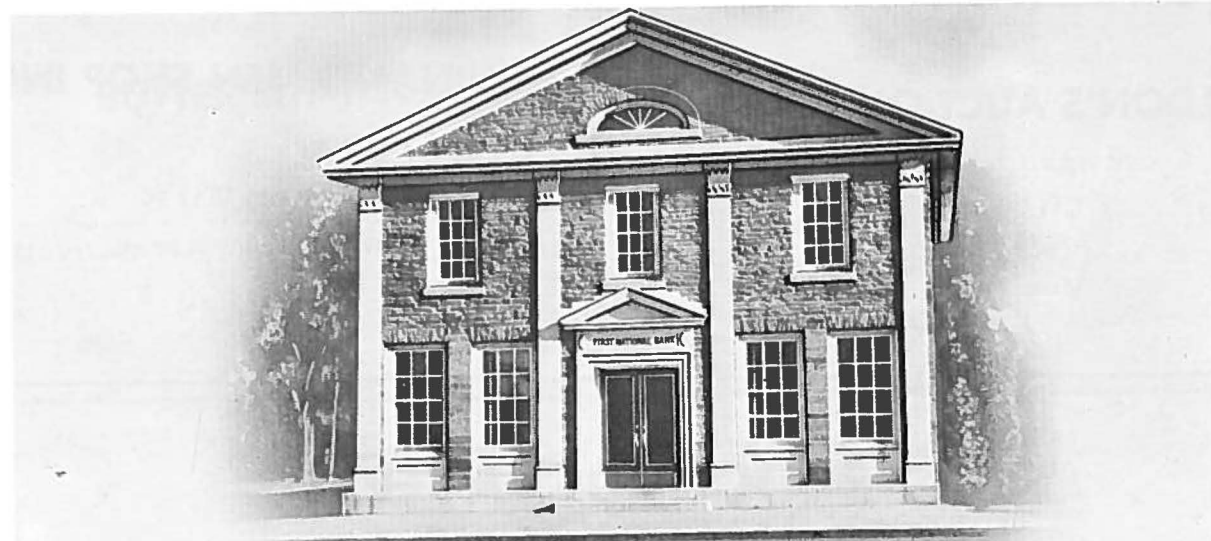

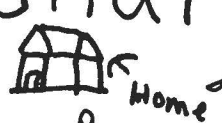
