**This morning arrived here the United States steamer Continental, Geo. Sumner, master, from New York, via Hilton Head and Key West, to U. S. Quatermaster.**

**PASSENGERS:**  
Capt McClure, S B McClure, Lieut C B Knight, Lieut Tucker, Surg Swan, Surg G Halin, Lieut N A Norton, C B Smith, and ninety enlisted men in the steerage.

**The purser reports that the Continental left New York at 4 P. M. 20th inst., arrived at Hilton Head at 8 P. M. 23d, and left there at 4 P. M. the 24th. Arrived at Key West 9 P. M. the 26th, and left on the 27th at 5 P. M. Arrived here at 6:30 A. M., 30th. One of the best of this swift steamer's best passages. At 6 P. M. 27th, off Sand Key, passed steamer Empire City going into Key West.**

**Our dates by way of the river are later than those by this arrival. But our files afford us fuller details up to the 20th.**
