Building Plan Vote Slated Next Month

The Board of Education of the Lewis Hamilton School District has approved the plan for a \$50,000 addition to the Morris High School building. Mrs. Lewis Hamilton, 420 E. 1st St., has offered the sum for the purpose.

The addition to the original structure, as now proposed, would cost an estimated \$100,000. Approximately one-third of the total cost would be covered by the Lewis Hamilton School District. The remainder would be covered by the State Education Department and the State Bond Commission. The building would be used for classroom purposes and would contain 120 seats.
