

Death of Mrs. Augusta Bridges.

The Morris (N. Y.) Chronicle, of Wednesday, March 11th, 1891, contains the following notice of the death of Mrs. Augusta Bridges, the eldest sister of Burley and E. W. Follett deceased:

Died, on Wednesday afternoon, March 4th, at the residence of her son, Hon. Nathan Bridges, on Lake street in this village, Mrs. Augusta Bridges, wife of the late Lyman Bridges, after an illness of only a few hours, in the 86th year of her age. She with her husband moved from Laurens seven years ago to make their home with their only hving son Nathan, and here they both have died. Mrs. Bridges was a Christian woman, respected and beloved by all who knew her. Her funeral was attended on Friday afternoon at 3 o'clock, Rev. J. D. Roberts officiating, and her remains were placed in the receiving vault at Hillington cemetery. The bearers were J. P. Kenyon, C. A. Bowne, Rufus Sanderson, Amasa Winton, E. Wilcox and L. P. Carpenter.
