

Wenonah Names New Officer for Traffic Control

Wenonah, Feb. 13 — Appointment of Walter Hain Jr., of Monroe ave., as an assistant police marshal was confirmed Friday night by borough council.

Mayor William I. Conway said Hain would be on day traffic duty. The mayor has urged appointment of a day officer for the past two years to augment the present police department which includes only one other full-time officer, Police Chief George Bowker, who is on night duty.

The Wenonah Woman's Club endorsed the move to appoint a new officer. Thomas McCord, vice president of the Wenonah School Association, appeared at the meeting and said his group also has adopted a resolution agreeing with the plan.

Hain, a War II veteran, will begin his duties March 1, after adoption of the 1954 budget which provides funds for the added officer, Mayor Conway said.

The mayor also announced two local clergymen have volunteered for traffic duty on Wednesdays for school children who attend special church school classes in the community. They are the Rev. Robert B. Scott, pastor of First Presbyterian Church, and the Rev. David Wilson, pastor of Wenonah Methodist Church.

Council approved installation of new street lights at Jefferson and Maple aves., and at Elm and Princeton aves. Council also announced 94 street lights cost the borough \$340 annually.

A resolution was adopted approving the following annual salaries of borough employees: municipal judge, \$300; borough solicitor, \$40 and fees; borough engineer, fees; two-member board of assessors, \$125 each; secretary of assessors, \$350; tax search clerk, fees; fire house superintendent, \$220; tax collector and treasurer, \$1375; borough marshal, \$2420; borough clerk, \$1100; street supervisor, \$2310; superintendent of water utility, \$600; utility engineer, \$2350; clerk of water utility, \$600; superintendent of sewer utility, \$600; clerk of sewer, \$125, and laborers 88 cents and \$1 per hour.
