In this factory Panama hats from South America, and straw braid from Italy, China and Japan, are received in original bales and cases and by process of bleaching and coloring are converted into the beautiful shade of cream white that is now in demand by well-dressed men, and the endless variety of beautiful shades which adorn millions of our ladies on Easter Day parade.

Besides these, the R. H. Comey Company manufactures the well-known Komi Green Painted Porch Curtain, by which medium thousands of porches are beautified and made comfortable in the hot summer months.

Mr. Comey recently returned from a trip made to European countries where he viewed conditions in the different markets.
