## A bridge in Wenonah is getting a new life

A \$100,000 state grant will make the old span safe for schoolchildren once again.

WENONAH BOROUGHS — Father Tim has not had a day's work, but he is in the way for a crowded street and a wooden pedestrian bridge that has stood over the railroad tracks here since the turn of the century.

Word of a \$100,000 grant approved for rehabilitating the foot bridge that crosses the Central tracks and connects northeast and northeast Wenonah came to Mayor Dale T. Taylor on Nov. 25 from Thomas M. Davis, commissioner of the state Transportation Department.

"And I've told the borough engineer to go ahead with drawing up the plans and specifications for improvement," Taylor said recently.

The borough will put the project out to bid in January, and construction should begin in late February or early March, Taylor said.

The money will gladden the hearts of creative residents of the tiny borough who hold the structure dear and fear it is becoming a good scene to children who roam the open street next to and from school on Clinton Avenue before the bridge was deemed potentially hazardous and closed to traffic.

"It would be wonderful to see the bridge in good repair because it provides a safer way for young
