

LUMBER DEALER'S WILL LEAVES ESTATE TO SON

Woodbury, March 19.—The will of George H. Buzby, Philadelphia lumber dealer, of Wenonah, probated by Surrogate Frank D. Pedrick today, contained several bequeaths to institutions.

J. Harold Buzby, his son, and the Providence Trust Company, of Philadelphia, were named trustees and executors. The son receives full interest in the C. M. Buzby Lumber Company, of Philadelphia, and his wife, Mrs. Rosalie M. Buzby, received \$5,000. The bulk of his estate went to his widow, Mrs. Emily Buzby, to be held in trust. On her death it will be turned over to his son, free of trust.

The institutions mentioned were Friend's Meeting Place, of Woodstown, \$5,000 to be held in trust; Wenonah M. E. Church, \$5,000; Wenonah Public Library, \$1,000; Wenonah Cemetery Association, \$1,000, for a burial plot; and the Wenonah Fire Company, which was bequeathed the interest and all monies due from the state and county firemen's relief associations.
